

Camp TLC / Spina Bifida Association of North Texas Eligibility Policy

Decisions about which children are accepted to camp are made by SBANT's Camp Director Staff using the following criteria:

1. The child's age is within the range defined on the Camp TLC web site (<u>www.camptlc-sbant.com</u>) and application.

2. The child was born with spina bifida, or a closely related neurological birth defect.

3. The child resides in Texas. Out-of-state campers who otherwise meet the eligibility criteria will be considered if space is available, after acceptance of campers residing in Texas.

4. The camper application was complete and submitted on time.

5. Developmental Age of 6 or below will be reviewed by the Directors and Medical Team for Camp Appropriateness.

6. The Medical Director has approved the child as medically appropriate for a safe camping experience. Applicants may be requested to submit additional up-to-date medical records at the request of the Medical Director. If additional medical records are requested, the application is not complete until received.

7. The child has records demonstrating up-to-date age appropriate immunizations. See Immunization Policy for specific information. Note: Unlike many public schools, Camp TLC does not grant waivers for reasons of conscience.

Whether a family is able to pay the application fee is never considered when acceptance decisions are made.
